
### WRITING YOUR WILL

#### **OUR POLICY**

St Mary's is enormously grateful for legacy donations, and we understand that donors may wish to indicate how their donation is used.

Since it may be years or even decades before the time comes to fulfil the request, we strongly recommend donations be given in the most general terms.

All gifts will be acknowledged unless anonymity is requested, but permanent plaques or other such memorials would require separate consideration.

## SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL:

"I give \_\_\_\_\_% of my residuary estate OR I give the sum of £\_\_\_\_ (pounds only) free of all taxes to the Parochial Church Council of the Ecclesiastical Parish of St Mary the Virgin, Monkseaton in the Diocese of Newcastle for its general purposes, and I declare that the receipt of an officer of the PCC shall be sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees."

We strongly advise you see a solicitor when writing or amending your will.
